We cordially invite your students to participate in the International Students' Visual Arts Contest-cum-Exhibition of Hong Kong – Photography (HKISAC) 2013. The theme of this year's HKISAC is "My Place • My People".

Hong Kong is a cosmopolitan city keen on developing arts and culture, and promoting creative industries. Nurturing students' creativity and art abilities therefore plays a significant role in school education. The Education Bureau (EDB) of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) has launched the HKISAC jointly with Po Leung Kuk (one of the major charitable and education organisations in Hong Kong) since 2010. The HKISAC of the past years were so successful that thousands of young people's high quality artworks were submitted from more than 30 countries all over the world, culminating in the Prize Presentation and Opening Ceremony of the exhibition in which the Hong Kong Grand Prize winners from various countries were invited to Hong Kong to share the joy and success of this significant international art education event. - Event Title:** International Students' Visual Arts Contest-cum-Exhibition of Hong Kong – Photography (2013)
- Medium:** Photography
- Theme:** My Place • My People
- Presenters:** Education Bureau of the Government of the HKSAR and Po Leung Kuk
- Entrants:** Students of primary 4 / grade 4 or above of primary schools, and Students of secondary schools
- Judging panel:** Professional photographers, renowned artists, art educators

- Prizes:** 12 Hong Kong Grand Prizes. Each will be awarded US\$1,000 cash, a trophy and a certificate. For Hong Kong Grand Prize winners from outside Hong Kong, a return flight ticket to Hong Kong and 3-day accommodation in Hong Kong will be offered to attend the prize presentation ceremony.
- Other prizes:** A number of Honourable Mentions and Certificate of Merits
- Exhibition:** The prize awarded artworks (Hong Kong Grand Prize and Honourable Mention) will be exhibited in Hong Kong in August 2013.
- Entry Deadline:** 31 May 2013
